Project #4 - EDIT

- Double click the Avid Media Composer icon on the desktop, if it has not all ready been selected.
- In the Select Project folder, click on the Project 4 and then click OK. Turn on Caps Lock.
- In your section bin, select your section by double clicking the blue/green box to the left.
- In your section bin, right click the mouse below the clips and select new sequence.
- In the bin folder the untitled sequence that is highlighted, just type your last name.
- Double click on your section number clip(s). At the bottom of the Preview/Source screen and click at the beginning of its Timeline. Press Play (L) and find where the student starts saying the first word of the sentence (select the best take), Mark-In (I). Listen to the audio and when you hear the last word of the sentence, Mark-Out (O). Press 6 and listen to what you have marked. If your start was too early or late, press (Q). Then press the number 3 or 4 key to go back or forward one frame at a time until you get to the starting point and press Mark-In (I). Repeat the process but press (W) to go to the out point and press Mark-Out (O). Click the overwrite tab () or B.
- Repeat the previous step for the remaining 14 sentences.
- Return the blue vertical line on the Timeline to the beginning of the sentences by dragging it back and press Mark-In (I).
- Turn off Tracks V1, A1 and A2.
- In the Music Bin, select the Acetylene music Track by double clicking the blue/green box to the left.
- In the Music Track Bin, double click on the Music clip.
- Create two new audio tracks in the Timeline by right clicking the mouse and select New Audio Track twice. Place the mouse cursor on the far left A1 Tab and hold down the left button and drag it to the new A3 Tab in the Timeline. Next, place the mouse cursor on the far left A2 Tab and hold down the left button and drag it to the new A4 Tab in the Timeline.
- On the Preview/Source window, on the Timeline at the bottom, drag the blue line to the beginning of the clip.
- Click the overwrite tab () or B.
- On the Timeline click in the middle of the Music track. At the top of the left monitor, click on Tools. Next, go down to the Audio Mixer and select it. Right above faders 3 and 4, select both boxes. Pull the faders down to about -15 to -20 and close the Audio Mixer.
- Turn off tracks A3 and A4.
- Create a new video track in the Timeline by right clicking the mouse and select New Video Track.
- In the S10 Intro Project Master Bin, double click the Graphics blue/green box.
- Double click the Country Fest clip.
- Drag the blue vertical line on the Timeline to where you hear Country Fest in the sentences, press Pause (K). Backup a couple of frames. Press Mark-In (I) and find where you want the graphic to end and press, Mark-Out (O).
- Click the overwrite tab.
- Repeat the previous three steps for Rock Fest. R & B Fest, Thursday Nite live and Bluegrass Fest.
